Mr. Andrews made a motion to approve having the Farmington Village Corp Official Zoning Map added to the GIS Mapping.

Solar Project – Waiting to hear the results between CMP and the Solar Companies. CMP is saying that the cost CMP quoted to connect to the grid is now far more than originally anticipated.
